# **Superintendent (Traffic/Law Enforcement)**

## Basic salary: R180 224.88 per annum (excl benefits)

Minimum requirements: • A Grade 12 • A Traffic diploma/Examiner of Driver's Licence diploma • Additional qualifications in Traffic Management would be an added advantage • A Code C1 driver's licence • No criminal record • A minimum of 5 years' experience in a traffic environment • Mental and physical fitness • The ability to work shifts and travel after hours • Report-writing, investigative and communication skills • Registration as a Traffic Officer.
