DRAFT SHARK BIODIVERSITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, Ms. Barbara Creecy, published the draft "Shark Biodiversity Management Plan" in the Government Gazette for public comment in terms of sections 100 (1)(a) and (b) of the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act No.10 of 2004)

The goal of the draft Shark Biodiversity Management Plan (SBMP) is to achieve and maintain a favorable conservation status of sharks within South Africa's waters. The draft SBMP is seeking to formalise the conservation-oriented initiatives being undertaken on a national and regional scale and provide the mechanism whereby these efforts could be coordinated, directed, and implemented to the benefit of all shark species and their habitats. It has been identified that there was a need for alignment across sectors of conservation, management, research, and sustainable use, and the SBMP would serve as a tool for achieving this.
