The purpose of the Verification Guidelines is to support the implementation of the mandatory greenhouse gas reporting regime in South Africa. The Verification Guidelines provides direction to the Competent Authority, Data Providers and Independent Assessors on the verification process for the National Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reporting Regulations of 2017 and details the responsibilities of these role players. The Verification Guidelines are applicable to all anthropogenic emissions by sources and removals by sinks.
