Bidders are requested to attach their B-BBEE status level certificate. The certificate must be issued by SANAS accredited agencies. The Municipality has the right to check the validity of the certificate.

The municipality shall adjudicate and award tenders in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act. 5/2000 on 100 points for Functionality and on 80/20 points system where 80 points are for the price and 20 points for B-BBEE according to the said legislation.
