The quotations should be accompanied by proposals or company profile clearly indicating extensive Experience of the company. Proof of Banking details, proof of municipal services for the company and for the directors not older than 3 months. Joint venture agreements (if any) ,company certificates , Training accreditation certificates and tax clearance.

Bidders are requested to attach their B-BBEE status level certificate. The certificate must be issued by SANAS accredited agencies. The Municipality has the right to check the validity of the certificates. The preference will be given to the service providers listed with Makhuduthamaga Local Municipality.

No fax or email will be accepted.

The municipality shall adjudicate and award tenders in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act. 5/2000 on 100 points for Functionality and on 80/20 points system where 80 points are for the price and 20 points for B-BBEE according to the said legislation.
