Project synopsis: The Department of Social Development is supported through a Bilateral agreement between the South African and German governments to implement a programme targeting Orphans and Vulnerable Children and Youth aged 15-24 in South Africa. This programme is funded through the German Development Bank - KfW. It entails soft skills training and support services for orphans, vulnerable children and youth (OVY) aged 15 to 24 in 17 Community Care Centres (CCC) located in the provinces KwaZulu-Natal, North-West and Limpopo. The project aims to support OVCY in developing into responsible and self-reliant adults and integrate into the labour market and society. The activities of the programme - mostly soft skills training - will be implemented by a service provider.

The expected implementation period is 4 years. The implementation will start implementation in 6 CCCs and thereafter scale up to all 17 CCCs.

Requested services:

- Provide soft skills training and employment related skills training to young people 15-24 years in 17 CCCs. In addition, conduct skills transfer for staff at the CCCs.
- In addition, undertake the following activities for three months only: support the programme planning phase, conduct mapping of stakeholders in the vicinity of each CCC in relation to skills development and employment creation, identify and propose a package of hard skills for each CCC, identify income generating activities in the vicinity of the CCCs.

It is foreseen to award the contract to an organization or company with expertise in skills development, employment preparation and youth development in South Africa. Bidders may enter into consortia or subcontract part of the services. Qualifying bidders shall:
