RESOLUTION NO 84 OF 2021/2022 FINANCIAL YEAR

RESOLUTION ON WARD COMMITTEE ESTABLISHMENT POLICY AND ELECTION PROGRAMME

NOTING THAT:

1. The Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act 108 of 1996 Section 152 places the participation of communities at the center of service delivery and other matters of Local Government.
2. Section 73(3) of the Municipal Structures Act, provides that a Municipal Council must make rules regulating:
 - (a) The procedure to elect members of a Ward Committee taking into account the need :
 - (i) For women to equitably be represented in a Ward Committee
 - (ii) For a diversity of interests in the Ward to be represented
 - (b) The circumstance under which those members must vacate office and the frequency of meetings of Ward Committees
3. The Political Consultation meeting on the establishment of ward committees held between the Mayor, the Speaker and the wippery on the 1st February 2022 reached the following agreement
 - I. Presenters during ward Committee elections should not wear political regalia
 - II. Community members in attendance are both eligible to stand as candidates as well as voters , voting shall be conducted in all voting districts in the Municipality
 - III. Nominations will be conducted verbally and voting shall be by held by show of hands
 - IV. Where two candidates are nominated ,one of those must be



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female, where more than two candidates are nominated the majority must be female

- V. Any by-election post the elections of ward committees will only apply after 12 calendar month has lapsed, with the candidate who has polled the highest unsuccessful vote count assuming a seat in the ward should a vacancy arise in the intervening period.
- VI. Ward with unique characters e.g size should be given specific/appropriate attention
- VII. Residual numbers to make up the number of ten ward committee members will be finalized by the office of the Speaker and the relevant ward Councillor
- VIII. Issues of gender balance, disability representativity and geographic spread will be left to the Office of the Speaker in Consultation with relevant Ward Councillor
