The Acting Chief Justice of the Republic of South Africa, in his capacity as the Chairperson of the Panel comprising representatives of the South African Human Rights Commission, the Commission for Gender Equality and the Public Protector, established in terms of section 6 of the Electoral Commission Act, 1996 (Act No. 51 of 1996), hereby invites nominations for a vacancy of a member of the Electoral Commission.

The Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, read with the Electoral Commission Act, 1996, provides that members of the Commission must be men and women who:

- are South African citizens;
- are fit and proper persons to hold that office; and
- do not at that stage have a high party-political profile.

Members of the Commission are appointed by the President for a term of seven years. Nominations must indicate their availability to serve full-time or part-time.

Each candidate's nomination, accompanied by a motivation of suitability, if any, a candidate's written consent, copy of ID card, identity documents and comprehensive curriculum vitae, must be submitted on or before 18 February 2022 to the Office of the Chief Justice, Private Bag 110, Mafikeng, 0101 or hand delivered at 188, 14th Road, Norcor City, Mafikeng.
