DRAFT SECOND-GENERATION HIGHVELD PRIORITY AREA AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, Dr Dion T George hereby invite comments on the draft second-generation Highveld Priority Area Air Quality Management Plan, in terms of section 19(4), read with sections 56 and 57 of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act, 2004 (Act No. 39 of 2004).

The draft second-generation Highveld Priority Area Air Quality Management Plan builds on the progress of the first-generation plan, and incorporate targeted strategies to manage air quality more effectively and by specific stakeholders including:

(a) Any person conducting a listed activity.

(b) Any person operating a controlled emitter.

(c) Any holder of a right or permit related to a prospecting operation, exploration operation, mining operation, or production operation as defined in section 1 of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (Act No. 28 of 2002).

(d) Any person conducting reclamation and

(e) Any department of state or administration in the national, provincial, or local sphere of government.

The plan provides interventions and measures aimed at improving air quality through implementation of emission reduction targets by identified stakeholders to attain and sustain compliance with national ambient air quality standards. The emissions reduction targets to be attained by 2030 from the 2019 baseline include:

Sector	2030
Industry	40% Reduction on the baseline
Residential Waste Burning	100% Reduction on the baseline
On-road Vehicle Sources	30% Reduction on the baseline
Residential Fuel Burning	30% Reduction on the baseline
Biomass Burning	30% Reduction on the baseline
Agriculture	20% Reduction on the baseline
Windblown Particulates	40% Reduction on the baseline

The draft second-generation Highveld Priority Area Air Quality Management Plan incorporates improved monitoring and evaluation mechanisms for tracking the progress made by identified stakeholders in achieving the goals set out in the plan. These mechanisms are supported by improved coordination, compliance monitoring and enforcement through the proposed priority area enforcement regulations.

In addition to the draft second-generation Highveld Priority Area Air Quality Management Plan, the Highveld Priority Baseline Assessment Report has also been developed as an annexure to the plan. The baseline assessment report provides a comprehensive analysis of the current state of air quality in the Highveld Priority Area based on historical air pollution trends from 2007 to 2020, information on atmospheric emissions sources as of 2019 as well as air dispersion modelling outcomes that informed the development of emission reduction targets stipulated in the draft plan.
