The Municipality will adjudicate and award tenders in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 5/2000, and revised procurement regulations of June 2011, on 100 points for functionality and using the 90/10 points system where 90 points will be allocated to price and 10 points to B-BBEE (according to the said legislation). Tenders will remain valid for 90 (ninety) days. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted and the Municipality reserves the right not to consider any tender not fully completed. Tenderers are required to initial each page of the tender document and sign where necessary.
