

I'LL COME BACK STRONGER TO RECLAIM UFC BELT - DRICUS

 Undefeated Russian went into the fight as favourite

A brave but bloodied Dricus du Plessis surrendered his UFC middleweight crown to Russian Emirati Khamzat Chimaev on a points decision in Chicago on Saturday.

Chimaev dominated, scoring frequent take-downs and then punishing the now former champion with shots.

But Du Plessis produced a few moments of hope in the final fifth round, turning one take-down around and landing some good punches at distance, but it wasn't enough. All three judges scored it 50-44 for undefeated Chimaev, who went into the bout as the favourite and who described Du Plessis as a real African lion after the bout.

TimesLIVE reported that in his post-fight interview, Du Plessis said while he did not feel Chimaev was stronger, he

knew what he needed to do to maintain "incredible control". "At the end, I went for it and could almost taste the victory ... He beat me fair and square, and I'll be back and get my belt back.

"To everybody in SA, you all know this

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flag means the world to me. I am sorry to anyone I let down. I'll be back stronger ..." Du Plessis had reigned over middleweight division since winning the belt from Sean Strickland of the US in January last year.

He subdued Nigerian-New Zealander Israel Adesanya in August last year and dominated a rematch with Strickland in February this year.
